





There's something to be said for intelligent design. At the tony Remède Spa in the six-star St Regis Singapore, even the most finicky spa divas will be hard-pressed to find fault in its facilities. If God is in the details, then this place is heaven.

One of its winning features is the pure eucalyptusscented steam room with three chambers, with temperatures varying from 45 deg C to 55 deg C. Pick and choose the temperature you're comfortable with or start from the least hot chamber and gradually move up. This is perfect for people suffering from allergies or who don't do well with extreme heat.

Other stars include the heated wave loungers by the hydro-massage pools. Co-designed by expert spa consultant, Farida Chettab Brouwer (whose resumé also includes the spas at the Westin Resort in Nusa Dua and the W Retreat in the Maldives), and a physiotherapist, the ergonomic loungers are made of marble and infra-red heated to help loosen those muscles and ease the joints. Each lounger has

separate heating zones that can be controlled by the user.

The ice fountain is another first in town. A clever alternative

to the cold plunge pool (who really uses that?), that can border on masochism right after the sauna and steam bath, the fountain contains crushed ice chips that you can apply to the skin after the hot therapies. It's a gentler approach to stimulate blood circulation and the lymphatic system.

No expense was spared to create the Remède Spa for its debut outside of the US. Quite possibly the most luxurious and glamorous-looking spa in town right now, there are even personal iPods in the waiting area for the guests.
